2003: Youngest player on Great Britain squad at European Championship A-Pool in The Netherlands ... Tallied two hits against Spain in European Championship debut ... Also had hits against Germany, Belgium, and Croatia ... Made spectacular catch diving into left-field stand against Greece ... Pitched against El Camino College in game four of 2nd US try-out series in California ... Started at third base against El Camino College in game three of series. **2005:** Earned his first Great Britain victory on the mound against Croatia, allowing 2 earned runs in 5.2 innings at European Championship A-Pool in Czech Republic ... Pitched masterfully against The Netherlands yielding just 1 earned run in hard-luck loss ... Registered an at-bat against Russia and played defensively against Greece ... Threw 4.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision against the Czech Republic in Prague Baseball Week.
