Delivered hits in all seven games Great Britain played and had multi-hit performances against Germany, Slovenia, Croatia, and Russia ... On the mound, picked up victory against Slovenia. **2001:** Continued to be a leader at the plate, driving in a team-high 7 runs at European Championship A-Pool in Germany ... Registered a hit in every game of the tournament, including a three-hit game against Sweden and a two-hit game against Belgium. **2003:** Led Great Britain and was tied for third among all teams in runs scored (8) at European Championship A-Pool in The Netherlands ... Tournament leader in triples (two) ... Smacked three hits against Spain, two hits against Belgium, and a triple against Italy.
